## Prison

Give thanks for the open doors and opportunities for the PF prison staff- Dean, Paul, Michael and Joanne to visit and share the gospel with the men and women in our prisons.

Pray for the weekly meetings in the prisons and for the Christian men and women attending to be built up in their faith and encouraged.

Give thanks for the faithful volunteers who give of their time each week and share the message of Jesus in sometimes a very challenging environment.

Another 'Sycamore Tree' Restorative Justice course has just started in all 3 prisons. We thank the Lord for this opportunity and pray He will lead each course, and touch hearts to bring lasting hope, change and restoration.

Pray for 'A', who suffers from alcohol and drug addiction and is really having a hard time presently. His father has been admitted to hospital and is very ill. 'A' is doing his best to change his life around. PF staff pray regularly with him, but he still finds it hard to cope, especially with deteriorating mental health.

## Volunteer

Praise God for another successful Christmas Hope with over 70 volunteers helping to pack, sort and deliver hampers. We are truly thankful for the men and women who came forward from various churches to serve those in our care. Thank-you for your faithful prayers.
